No Rafts at all on Holiday Weekends

Footballs \* Tennis Balls \*Basket Balls \* Soccer Balls  
Are prohibited in the pool area at all times.

Boisterous or Rough Play, Pushing, Acrobatics, Dunking, Wrestling,  
Offensive or Disruptive Splashing or Yelling,  
Jumping without care and caution, Snapping of towels,  
Improper conduct causing undue disturbances on or about the pool  
area or any acts which would endanger any patron are prohibited.

No Glass Containers of any kind may be brought into pool area.  
EZ Up/Pop Up Tents & Umbrellas over 5ft Must have one side  
placed along the west external fence line.

Any injury occurring in the pool or pool area must be reported to a  
Pool Attendant or Pool Manager immediately.

Evacuation will be required at the first sound of thunder  
and/or whenever the flash-to-bang count is less than 30 seconds,  
indicating the storm in close proximity.

The pool will not reopen until 15 minutes after the last clap of thunder  
and/or at a sufficient time that the Pool Attendant deems safe.

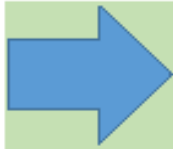
