Dear Members,

As we approach our MCA Fourth of July celebration, I want to take a moment to reflect on the ideals of freedom and community that this holiday represents. Independence Day is not only a time to celebrate our nation's birth, but also a perfect opportunity to come together as a community that cherishes family, camaraderie, and shared experiences.

At our campground, we have the unique privilege of gathering in an environment that fosters connection with the great outdoors. It's a time to enjoy family barbecues, fireworks, and s'mores by the campfire, all while appreciating the natural beauty that surrounds us. Whether you're cruising on your golf cart, swimming in our lake, or gathering at the pavilions for private and community events, these moments are the essence of what makes our campground special.

Let's come together to celebrate the spirit of independence and the joys of camping. We have planned a fantastic lineup of activities for the weekend, including:

Your participation in safeguarding our facilities is vital to the success of our campground. If you see something, say something. Report any concerns to security, the office, or your section reps. Vandalism and destruction hurt every camper due to an increase in dues and an inability to use our facilities. All violators will be held accountable according to our ByLaws and Rules and Regulations.

To help keep everyone safe and have an enjoyable weekend, encourage your guests to read and abide by our rules.

A few key ones to remember:

- There will be a lot of vehicles and walkers on our roads. Follow our 10-mph speed limit and come to a complete stop at all stop signs. Take it slowly and watch out for our children.
- All pets must be on a leash. Clean up after your pet goes to the bathroom. Don't allow your dog to bark at all hours of the day and night. Keep your dog indoors during the fireworks. Dogs are not permitted in the beach area at the lake.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult while swimming in the lake. There is no night swimming. Swimming is only permitted in the beach area. There are no lifeguards, and swimming is at your own risk. Cars and golf carts should park in the grass lot across from the beach so there is enough space for swimmers since the pool is closed.
- Children 12 and under must be accompanied by an adult at the dance, rec room, and other MCA events. No alcohol is permitted in the teen rec room.

Together, we not only create memories but also keep each other safe and nurture the environment for future generations to enjoy.

On behalf of the board and staff, I wish you a safe and joyful MCA Fourth of July. Let's honor our freedoms, appreciate our campground, and make unforgettable memories together!

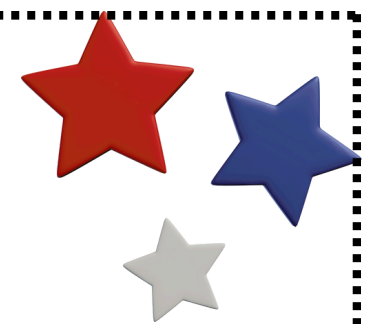
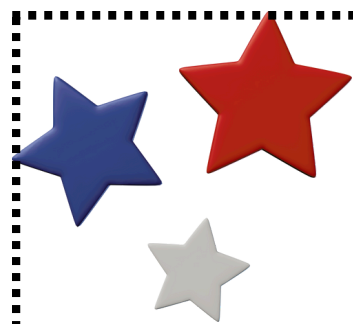
REMINDER
