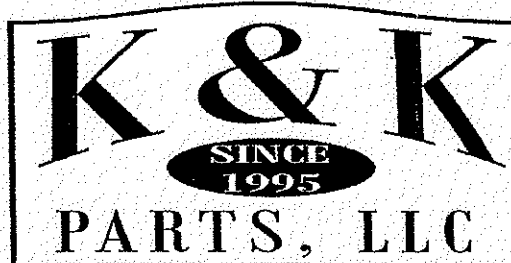

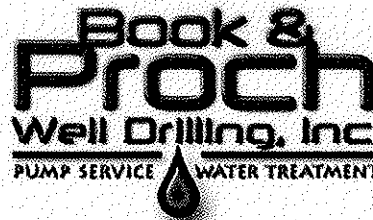

I would also like to thank all of the incumbent BOD members for their warm welcome and to the other new BOD members for their passion to work together in ALL of our desires for a GREAT FAMILY CAMPGROUND.

As the TEEN Committee Liaison and committee member I will be working diligently on building a relationship with the teens and place for our teens to have a camp where they feel that they are a part of ... this being said, due to the hard work and fund raising of past teen committees, the TEENS will be getting a place they can call their own. 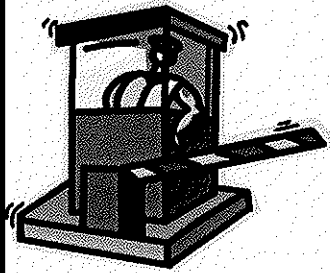

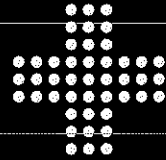

Dear MCA Membership:

Over the past several weeks you have probably been hearing of an issue we experienced in our office. After discussion with the staff person in question, the BOD felt (unanimously) it was necessary to part ways with that employee.

It came to light at a regular audit and budget meeting in January and on January 15th, after a few days investigation by a current board member, that funds were missing from one of our committee accounts. With this information in hand, that board member, along with a second, requested a special meeting of the BOD for January 19th. The entire Board took action at that special meeting with complete solidarity. After this meeting we contacted our auditors, the attorney and the authorities. On January 20th and 21st we contacted our Auditors and Attorney to investigate the missing funds. After receiving the Auditors report on February 25th we then contacted the authorities. The auditors reviewed not only the committee funds but also our corporate accounts. We will not be naming the person in question at this time, as we stand by the legal standard of innocent until proven guilty. We have taken action and we felt as a board we had sufficient proof from our own internal investigation to take these next steps. We have contacted the authorities and will cooperate fully with the police investigation. **We believe in transparency and we will not act to shield anyone involved in this matter.** The only reason for the delay in sending this notice is due to the request from our Auditors to wait until they could complete their review.

The BoD has and is working hard to make MCA an organization you can trust to do what is best for the members we serve. We ask that you keep an open mind and please alert any board member of any rumors you may hear or of any inappropriate communications you may receive from present or former board members or employees. We all hope to bring this unfortunate chapter to a close as quickly as possible.

We will continue to offer all the same amenities as we always have. We hope you will continue to support us and allow us to regain your trust. There will be changes made to the way the our records are audited, which will include even stronger controls then in place currently, to ensure this type of thing will never happen again.

Please feel free to contact any board member with questions. We will do our best to answer all questions in full.

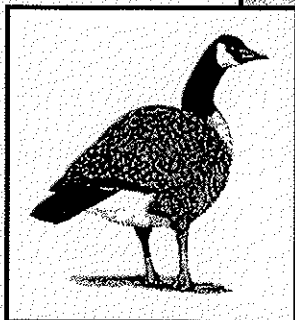

DON'T FEED THE GEESE

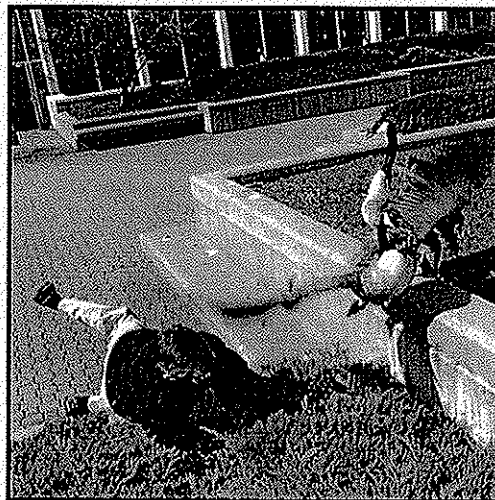


GENERAL BACKGROUND

People residing in urban and suburban areas enjoy seeing and interacting with wildlife. Feeding ducks and geese brings these birds into proximity to people. People that feed wildlife feel they are helping the birds and this provides these people with a sense of well-being and excitement. To the ducks and geese, however, the result of relying on handouts is devastating. Feeding popcorn, bread, or shelled corn is like feeding a child junk food since the geese are not receiving a balanced diet. This activity is a very selfish pursuit when only one party, humans, derives a benefit.

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN GEESE LOSE THEIR FEAR OF HUMANS?

Geese that are fed by well-meaning people lose their natural fear of man and reside closer than normal to humans. This can lead to violent attacks during the nesting season (March, April, May), especially to people who are afraid of geese. Most injuries occur when the person is backing away from the attacking gander and trips over a curb, planter, bumper block, or steps. Parks, businesses, apartment or condo associations may be held legally liable for physical or psychological damages. Thus, the goose feeding creates justifiable public health and safety concerns.

REMEMBER HOLIDAY WEEKENDS it is \$10 per car load. Do not pass gate cards at or around the gate or campground area on the holiday weekend. If you are caught doing so you will be written up and billed for any guest that are let through without purchasing a guest pass. Anyone not on the lease will have to have a guest pass paid for by MCA member before they are allowed in camp. Members must sign guest passes ahead of time. Guests cannot be let in just by giving us \$10.

TRANSFERS

A lot of campers have asked lately about LEASE TRANSFERS:

If you are transferring or deleting names off your current lease, you need pay the office \$25 to start the paperwork and the name(s) of the person(s) to be changed or deleted to or from the lease. ** If you are adding new names then we will be running a back ground check on new members and that is \$35.00 per person getting a back ground check done.** Then we need at least three days to type a new lease and get the back ground checks conducted (the background check could take longer). After that is completed, all of the people on the lease now, including the person who is going to be deleted, need to sign off the old and new lease and the amount due at signing is another \$125 for a total of \$150. If there has been a death \$25.00 of the transfer fee will be waived.

GATE CARDS

If you lose a gate card or it is stolen, we need the numbers of the cards you still have in your possession to determine the card number that was lost or stolen so that it can be deleted from our system. The cost to replace that card is \$5 if I can determine its number. If you do not tell me the numbers of your other cards the cost to replace it is \$25.

*****WE DO NOT SELL GATE CARDS ON HOLIDAY WEEKENDS*****

Remember you can start making payments on next year's dues at any time. Just be sure to write your lot number and what the check or money order is for in the memo line of the check or money order.
