Welcome back!

It has been a long winter but the staff and BOD have been busy throughout the off-season in preparing for this coming season. Some items to mention, we completed the project at the main building in correcting the drain issues within the men's room, and the laundry room. This project became much bigger than initially projected, and has resulted in a completely upgraded facility. Please take care of this, as this was your money that accomplished this renovation. We also have been working with our engineering firm in designing and planning for the sewage plant replacement, which is much needed. We should have further information on this project in early June, ahead of our scheduled July meeting to vote on usage of funds from the BIA account, as communicated previously. The Audit & Budget team have been quite busy, and we have implemented a totally new and updated system for tracking all funds for both corporate accounts and committee accounts. This will provide tremendous dividends now and in the future in our ability to track and report funds. We were able to add some additional funds this year for the following infrastructure items, tree removal, roads and vehicles. We provided an additional \$33,000 to these three areas for 2015 to help keep our infrastructure up to date. In the coming weeks tours of our water plant and sewage plant will be made available to members, so watch out for time and day if you are interested in these tours. Understanding and seeing first hand our plants helps educate the members on where their monies are going. Numerous other projects were undertaken by our staff and other volunteers, too numerous to mention. I have appointed a short term committee to review options for providing better security for our facility, this group will be reviewing and pricing out all options available then presenting that data to the BOD for review. We understand nothing we do can or will eliminate theft issues within our gates, but the committee will research whether anything can be done to try to provide better monitored security. More information on this will be provided in the coming months. In closing, as is always communicated, we have great volunteers that provide the functions that everyone enjoys, but all committees can always use additional volunteers. Think about it, even a few hours a month will provide help to our committees.

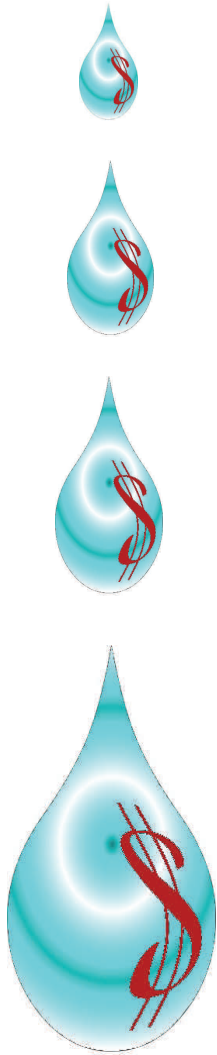

Water Saving Tips

Check the connection at your hydrant and at the RV inlet to ensure there are no leaks.

Repair any leaking faucets

Take Shorter Showers

Outfit any exterior hoses with a shut-off nozzle which can be adjusted down to a fine spray so that water only sprays when needed. When finished, "turn it off" at the faucet instead of the nozzle to avoid leaks

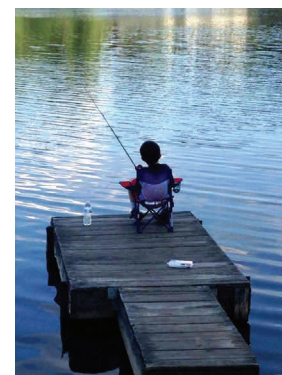

SEWAGE PLANT ASSESMENT

WE NEED YOUR VOTE

Vote to use or not use the BIA funds
 for the sewage project

Sunday July 5th

 A-FRAME

The Bia fund of just over \$315.000.00 was set up specifically for this project over 20 years ago. It was also protected by a vote of the membership that required a vote of the membership in order to allow the BOD to utilize these funds.

We will need just shy of 200 votes in order to have a quorum. So please get the word out, as the vote to use these funds will lower the cost per campsite by approximately \$350.00.

We are requiring that the sewage assessment funds be paid by September 1, 2015. The exact amount will be discussed and determined at the July meeting, one week after this vote has been taken.

If you have or see any issues in camp that need to be fixed, please contact the office and ask them to complete a work order. This way the issues can be tracked.
