As to the park, we are a little short staffed at the moment, but Bambi and Evelyn are keeping up in the office. Jon and his crew are working hard to get the park opened and spruced up for the "opening". I would also like to call a few other things to mind. Any building projects you have planned for this year, you **must** have a building permit, no exceptions. If you do not, your project **will** be shut down. Please watch your speed in the park. For those of you who do not know, the speed limit is 10mph. We have so many small children here and we do not want any tragedies, so please obey.

The BOD has decided to close the trash area nightly at 7:30pm and reopen at 8:30am daily. There is to be no disposal of rubbish in this area between the closed hours. There are cameras and a \$100.00 fine if caught. We had to do this to keep people from going down at night and illegally dumping non-household trash. Our refuse company will charge us up to \$1,000.00 per month extra, which we have not budgeted for if there is any overflow or trash lying next to the dumpsters or in front of the gate that they have to pick up. It's your money folks, remember that! Also, please do not bother the staff when they are working. Follow the established procedures that are in place if you need help from the staff. We have zero tolerance for anyone abusing members of our staff. We would also like to welcome Ellie and Jimmy Christopher back to our store.
