FROM A SECTION REP

I would like to welcome back all of the campers.

As the Liaison for the ERT (Emergency Response Team), I would like to highlight some of the rules and regulations that are in place to keep you, your family and fellow campers safe.

All vehicles must travel no faster than **10 miles** per hour on camp property. Stop signs must be obeyed, please note additional stop signs have been placed around the campground. This includes automobiles, golf carts and bicycles. Golf carts should not be operated by any person under the age of 18 and all persons on the golf cart should be seated, no standing is allowed. Children are not permitted to sit on an adults lap and steer the golf cart. Golf carts must be equipped with a front head light and rear lights if operated after dark. The golf cart must have a proof of insurance sticker displayed. The lot number must be identified on both the front and back of the golf cart. At sundown all bicycle riders must have a working headlight and reflectors must be on the front, rear and sides of the bike.

In the pool and lake area no diving is allowed. When crowded conditions exist in the pool/lake area no horseplay or playing ball will be permitted; and oversize rafts will not be permitted inside the lake or pool area. The overcrowded conditions will be established by MCA Pool/Lake Security staff. All boats using the lake must have a Coast Guard approved floatation device for each occupant. Children twelve (12) years of age and under must wear life jackets while in a boat. Standing in or jumping from a boat is prohibited. Oversized Rafts are considered boats outside of the swimming area and must adhere to these rules. Boats taken out after dark must have a working white light that is clearly visible.

No camp fires will be permitted on windy days or when "Dry Woods" conditions exist. A water source should be kept handy at or near the fire. All fires must be extinguished or covered prior to retiring for the day or leaving the campsite.

Last, there are two defibrillators available in the event someone has a heart attack or are found unresponsive. One is located at the guard shack and the other is located in the A-frame.

In the event of an emergency, it is very important that medical personnel can find your campsite. Please protect yourself and others by ensuring your campsite is properly marked and the lot number is at least 3 inches in height and visible to the road. Let's make this a safe, happy and healthy camp season. Stay safe!

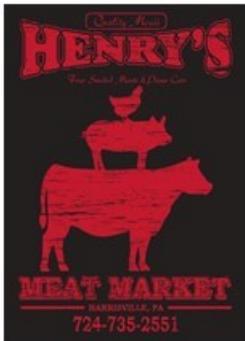

FROM OUR OFFICE

Hello all from the Office Staff!

With the new season starting, I would like to explain the process for performing and completing a lease transfer. The first step is the background check. If the Purchaser is not already a member, they **MUST** have a background check that is done through our approved company. No other background check can be used, we must run our own. The next step is getting approval from two of our officers which requires their signatures. Third, the office staff will call to let you know when this is completed to try to set the date and time for the transfer. If you would like to schedule a date or time, you have to call at **least 48 hours prior** to the completion of the lease transfer. We will not perform any transfer without the adequate notice. We need time to prepare the paperwork to make sure everything is correct. When dates are approved, we can complete the transfer. Additionally, when you come in for the transfer, make sure to bring your Photo ID and the Check/Money Order/Credit-Debit Card to pay for the transfer. The cost for this is \$500.

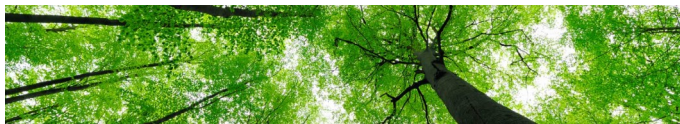
